

PRESIDENTS REPORT 2020

Firstly, let me start by offering my condolences to those of you who have lost family and friends throughout the past year.

In 2019 the Board of Directors commenced with a strategic plan to upgrade certain areas of the club in order to attract new members and visitors. The renovations included the purchase of new indoor and outdoor furniture, painting, new lighting to the internal and external areas of the club, a new decking for alfresco dining, a giant television screen, for the viewing of sports and the advertising of club facilities, on street level, where colourful flags were installed. These renovations have proven to be a great success as we have had many new people joining our club and many more people visiting. These renovations have also promoted barefoot bowls which is slowly catching on. The renovations have increased sales throughout all areas of the club. Great job by our current Board.

We found that during rainy weather, half of our decking was getting wet and unusable, the Board have since approved the installation of awnings on the decking area to protect from the rain and the extreme sun during winter. The awnings will be installed and completed in October.

The 2019 – 2020 financial report shows a small loss of \$95,118, this was mainly attributed to the loss in revenue during the clubs closure, from March to July covid19 shutdown period. There was no cash lost, the loss of \$95,118 includes depreciation of \$132,000

At this point in time the club is currently trading quite well, due to the recent improvements, and we can only expect that this will only improve once Covid19 restrictions are relaxed.

Our Kitchen has consistently delivered terrific food, we find that word of mouth works best and people are bringing their friends to try our great food.

Our greens keeper, Chris Bell, continues with providing our bowlers with excellent conditioned greens, once again a big thank you from the bowlers for the excellent work you have produced throughout the year.


