2020 -2021

The Changes to the club which took place in 2020 were met with a great response from our members. In March 2021 we were informed, by our local licensing sergeant, that there were trading conditions, which we are required to adhere to. These conditions have had a detrimental affect on our trading. I have since applied to have the trading conditions changed.

We have made some minor improvements to the club during the time has been closed due to lock down. We have installed a new walk-in freezer in the bistro.
